Who can be painted?

Face painting is suitable for ages 2- 102 to enjoy !! However ,all participants must be willing to be painted and prepared to sit still for the period of time required.

Unfortunately, for Health & safety reasons we are unable to paint anyone with cold sores, conjunctivitis or any other infections or skin complaints. Similarly eczema, acne or open cuts and grazes are not a suitable surface to paint. However, a design on hand or arm may be possible. Please feel free to ask for advice.

We are unable to paint anyone suffering from cold / flu symptoms. Without prejudice we reserve the right to refuse to paint anyone we feel should not be painted.

It is the responsibility of the person responsible for the child, to inform us of any reason medical or otherwise why the child should not be painted. This includes children with sensitive skin, which we must be informed of before painting commences. We can carry out a small skin patch test which will be left on for 20 minutes to see if a reaction occurs. Please feel free to ask for a patch test if in any doubt.

We need a clean face/surface to paint; so we have baby wipes available for parent/guardians to wipe noses and mouths if necessary before we start.

It is the responsibility of the client to inform parents /guardians/ carers that a face painter is present at the party / event and to inform us if a particular child is not to be painted! If parents are leaving the premises it is the clients responsibility to make them aware that Face Painting is taking place and to inform us if any child is not to be painted,for whatever reason.Alternatively if preferred by the client we can supply individual consent forms to be signed by parents and returned to us. if this option is chosen we will only be able to paint children who have returned signed consent forms.

We are face painters and not childminders and are not responsible for looking after children. Therefore we will not be held liable for anything that happens to a child either in or out of our face painting area. All children remain the responsibility of Parent /Guardian / Carer / Party host / Client.



About Our Products

We only use top quality face paints and glitters that comply with FDA/ EEC regulations. They are water based, have anti-bacterial and hypoallergenic properties and are specifically designed for cosmetic use on the face.

We follow strict codes of hygiene. All equipment including brushes and sponges are washed and sanitized. Water is also kept clean and changed regularly. As with any cosmetic product, we can not guarantee a reaction will not occur. (As with any cosmetics, some people may develop sensitivity to one of the ingredients. Children can be allergic to a wide range of common products). Please ask for a patch test if concerned in any way.

We will not be held liable for any child / adult who may react to paints or equipment.



Removing face paint

Removing face paint is simple and easy to achieve with a damp sponge / flannel and soap if necessary. Baby wipes may be used if preferred. Some colours may leave a temporary tinge on skin but do not worry as it will fade within a day or so.

Clothing that has been in contact with face paints should be firstly COLD soaked overnight in biological powder before washing normally. We do not accept liability for any damage to a person or their property.



Other Information

The client is responsible for providing parking or paying parking costs incurred by the artist. The artist should not be expected to work over the agreed time - If the client wishes to extend the time booked this may be possible with the agreement of both parties for an agreed extra fee. This may not always be possible due to other commitments.

Subcontracting- if a job is not undertaken by myself for whatever reason but is undertaken by another face painter then the job becomes the responsibility of the other face painter and no liability will be held by Moore Funny Faces.



Deposits and Insurance

A minimum £20 non-refundable deposit is required to confirm a booking. Please return your booking confirmation and deposit within 7 days of receipt. Deposits are non-refundable should you cancel your booking for any reason. If you cancel your booking 14 days or less prior to the event the FULL BALANCE must be paid. If the booking is cancelled 15-21 days prior to the event 50% of the balance must be paid.

Deposits are refundable only if the artist is unable to fulfil the booking .I will not be liable for circumstances beyond my control which make it impossible to for me attend your function (sickness ,traffic etc.)
